Short description:

Ocenaudio is a free, cross-platform, easy-to-use, fast, and functional audio editor. It is designed for simple and quick audio editing tasks, making it ideal for users who need to edit and analyse audio files without the complexity of a full Digital Audio Workstation (DAW). It's commonly used by podcasters, voiceover artists, students, and content creators for tasks like trimming clips, applying effects, and basic noise reduction. Despite its simplicity, it includes powerful features such as VST plugin support, real-time effect preview, and a fully featured spectrogram.

Key strengths:

- User-friendly and intuitive interface, suitable for beginners and advanced users alike.
- Cross-platform compatibility: Available for Windows, macOS, and Linux with a consistent interface across all systems.
- Real-time preview of effects: Allows users to hear the processed audio as they adjust effect parameters.

- VST plugins support: Extends functionality with numerous audio effects from third-party plugins.
- Efficient editing of large files: Utilises an advanced memory management system to handle long audio files without consuming excessive RAM.
- Multi-selection for precise edits: Enables simultaneous selection of different portions of an audio file for editing or applying effects.
- Fully featured spectrogram: Provides a powerful view for detailed spectral content analysis with real-time settings adjustments.
- Lightweight and fast performance, runs smoothly even on older or less powerful hardware.
- Supports a wide range of audio formats for import and export (e.g., MP3, WAV, OGG, FLAC).

Limitations:

- Limited multi-track editing capabilities: While it can handle multiple files in separate tabs, it is not a full-fledged multi-track editor like a DAW (e.g., you cannot easily layer multiple audio tracks for mixing).
- No autosave or recovery feature for interrupted recordings, which can lead to data loss if the application crashes.
- Fewer advanced built-in effects or plugins compared to more professional or feature-rich audio editors.
- No built-in MIDI support.
- Not open-source, unlike some alternatives like Audacity.
