### Short description:

LanguageTool is a multilingual writing assistant that checks spelling, grammar, and style in texts. Available as a web app, browser extension, and add-on for word processors, it helps improve written content in multiple languages, making it a valuable tool for educational projects, storytelling, and accessible communication.

### Key strengths:

- Free version supports grammar and spelling checks in multiple languages.
- Easy to use via web, browser extensions, or integrated into text editors.
- Detects grammar, spelling, punctuation, and style issues.
- Helps develop language accuracy, clarity, and editing skills.
- Valuable for writing stories, educational materials, and inclusive content.

### Limitations:

- Free version limits the number of suggestions and checks for longer texts.
- Some advanced features (style improvement, synonym suggestions, tone checks), only available in premium.
- Occasional errors or missed issues, especially in complex or creative texts.
